- i) **Private Candidates who withdraw from one or more syllabuses may apply for a refund of fees provided such application is received no more than 1 month after the closing date for registration. - ii) Candidates who are unable to take any examinations due to either acceptance at higher institutions of learning or medical conditions may apply for a refund. **The application should be made immediately and must be supported by either a letter of offer from the institution or a report from a registered medical practitioner.**
