# RESCHEDULING OF THE 2019 JCE AND BGCSE EXAMINATION TIMETABLES DUE TO GENERAL ELECTIONS DATE

The Botswana Examinations Council (BEC) would like to inform all examination centres, candidates and the public at large about the 2019 JCE and BGCSE examinations papers that have been *re-scheduled* following the announcement of the General Elections date and the paid holidays declared by the Office of the State President.

The re-scheduling only affects examination papers that were supposed to be written on 23, 24 and 25 October, 2019.

The examinations that were to be held on the 23, 24 and 25 October 2019 have been rescheduled as follows:

The BEC will issue revised examinations timetables to all JCE and BGCSE centres. Candidates are requested to obtain their revised Statement of Entry from their centres/schools. Private candidates should log onto the Malepa application for their revised Statements of Entry.
