**1 Information for Private Candidates**

You are advised to read this notice carefully. It contains information about the subjects and options which are available to Private Candidates and about where the examinations can be written.

You are responsible for your registration, and errors that occur as a result of mistakes on your part may not be corrected once the fees have been paid. You must make sure that you leave the Registration Form at the Finance Counter at BEC when you pay your entry fees.

You are advised to listen to Radio Botswana regularly as there may be announcements about the examinations.

**2 How to Register**

You must follow these instructions carefully.

- (a) Complete the form BEC 8/1 which can be obtained from the offices of the Botswana Examinations Council.
- (b) Submit the form BEC 8/1 to BEC with 2 passport size photos.
- (c) Confirm your choice of subjects and options with BEC officers who will be available to help you.
- (d) Pay the fees at the Finance Counter.
- (e) Leave the completed form BEC 8/1 at the Finance Counter.
- (f) Make sure that you have a receipt for the money you have paid before you leave the Finance Counter.

**You will receive your Statement of Entry some time after you have registered. Contact BEC by telephone (3184383) if you have not received your Statement of Entry by the end of May.**

#### 4 Repeating subjects with a Coursework Component

Subjects with a Coursework Component are not normally available to Private Candidates. However, you can be entered for some of these subjects if you were a candidate for the subject in 2009. The mark you were awarded for Coursework in 2009 will be carried forward, and you will not do any Coursework in 2010. This arrangement applies to the following subjects:

0586 Development Studies  
0595 Design & Technology  
0599 Agriculture  
0615 Business Studies

If you enter for one of these subjects, you must complete the Section 'Previous Candidate Details' on the Entry Form. If you do not provide details of your previous centre number and candidate number, your mark cannot be carried forward and you will not be graded.

The arrangement for carrying forward coursework marks does **not** apply to the following subjects. These are not available to you.

0596 Art & Design  
0597 Computer Studies  
0611 Food & Nutrition  
0612 Fashion & Fabrics  
0613 Home Management  
0616 Physical Education

Note that you cannot be entered for any subject or option which is not listed on pages 3, 4 or 5

## 7 Refunds

Private Candidates who withdraw from one or more syllabuses may apply for a refund of fees providing that any such application is received no more than 2 months after the closing date for registration. Candidates must provide proof of payment.

BEC reserves the right to withhold part of the fees paid by the candidate. The proportion of the fee which will be withheld will be determined by BEC from time to time.

Fees paid for registration in one examination series may not be transferred to another examination series. So, for example, fees paid in one year may not be transferred to the following year.

## **8 Entry Amendments**

You will be allowed to make changes to your entry up to 30 April. After that date, new candidates will not be allowed to register. In exceptional circumstances, existing candidates may be allowed to change their entry, but penalty fees will be charged as follows:

A change of option will be charged at P130 up to 6 September. The charge will be P270 from 7 September. No changes can be made after 4 October.

If a subject is added or changed, the charge will be P375 up to 6 September. From 7 September, the charge will be P515 for each subject which is added or changed. No changes can be made after 4 October.
